

How to find us

— We are 6 miles east of Evesham

FROM THE M5 - Travelling from the north, take exit no. 6, signed Evesham and Worcester. From the south, take exit no. 9, signed Evesham and Tewkesbury. We are approximately 30 minutes from the M5.

BY RAIL - We are on the London (Paddington) to Hereford line. Some trains stop at Honeybourne. We are 5 minutes walk from the station and 15 minutes by taxi or bus from Evesham.

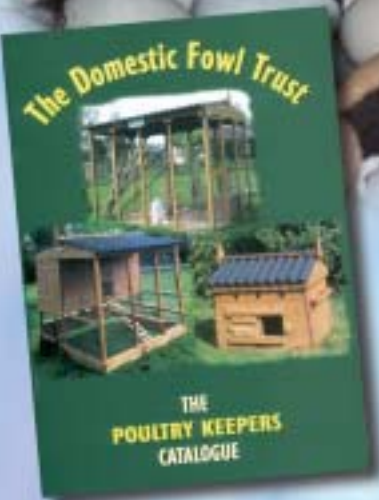

Come and visit the Domestic Fowl Trust the premier conservation centre for rare breeds of poultry and livestock.

Over 100 different varieties are on view at our 29-acre Honeybourne Farm and visitors can wander along the grass pathways to see breeding flocks of chickens, ducks, geese and turkeys. See the British bantams in their Tudor style hen houses or the American bantams in their 'barns'. Feed the numbers of wild mallard and greylag geese, which fly in to join the fun.

The Speckled Hen Tea-room is open all year round for light refreshments and snacks. It is also available to be booked for children's parties.

The farm animals include our rarest British breed of cow the Irish Moiled and also some of the rarest breeds of sheep and goats.

During the season there are ducklings and chicks hatching each week and these can be seen in the barn.

You can help in our conservation work by becoming a supporter of the Trust or adopting an animal.

One of the aims of the Domestic Fowl Trust is to encourage the keeping of poultry and to help new owners discover the joys of having their own hens. We have a shop selling an extensive range of quality poultry equipment, books and poultry houses. There are usually several breeds of hens to choose from, from day old chicks onwards. Staff are available to give you advice on what to buy and starter kits are our speciality. For those who cannot keep the real thing we have a wide selection of gifts and toys.

We have opened an activity room for children and school parties. We also have a new poultry museum and information area where you can discover interesting facts about chickens.

For the younger visitor there is an adventure playground and for the very young an indoor soft play area.
